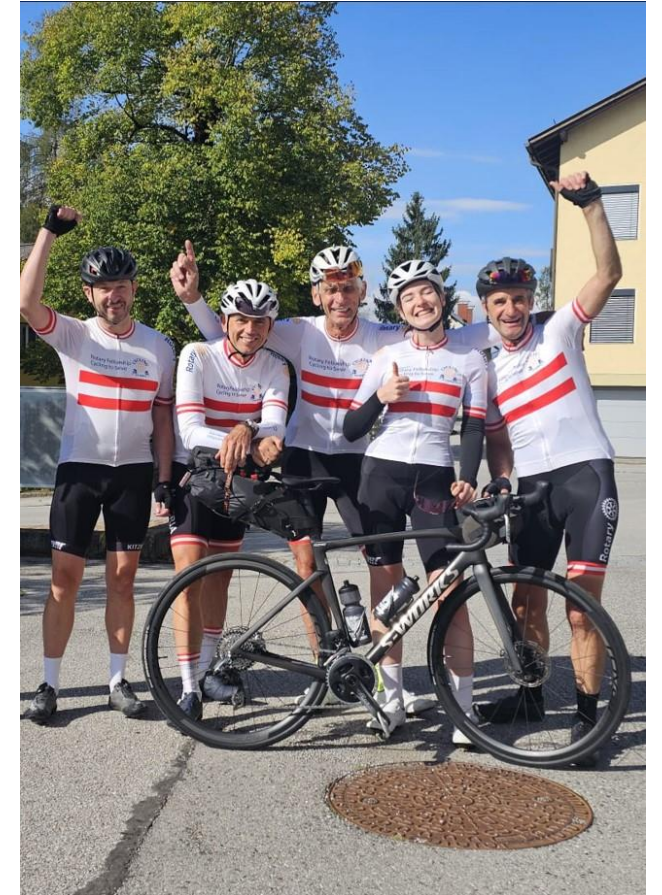

- The Rotary Cycling World Championships (RCWC) have been held annually since 1985
- 2026 we expect 100 Rotary cyclists plus approx. 70 non-cyclists from around the world
- Focus on friendship, casual and competitive cycling and fundraising
- RCWC 2026 shall be truly international:
English as event language
- Event activities cover cycling and non-cycling activities, exploring the area of Kitzbühel
- Organizer: Rotary Club Kitzbühel and Rotary Cycling Fellowship Austria

Our Goals for 2026 RCWC

- 1. Become more female**
→ 40% women cyclists
- 2. Become younger**
→ 40% of participants under 40 (Rotaract)
- 3. Become more international**
→ 40% of participants outside DE, AT, CH
- 4. Promote spirit of Rotary**
→ Friendship is more important than competition
- 5. Fundraising for donations**
→ Still pursuing the 'Cycling to Serve' motto
- 6. Regional value creation**
→ Promotion of Kitzbühel as a destination

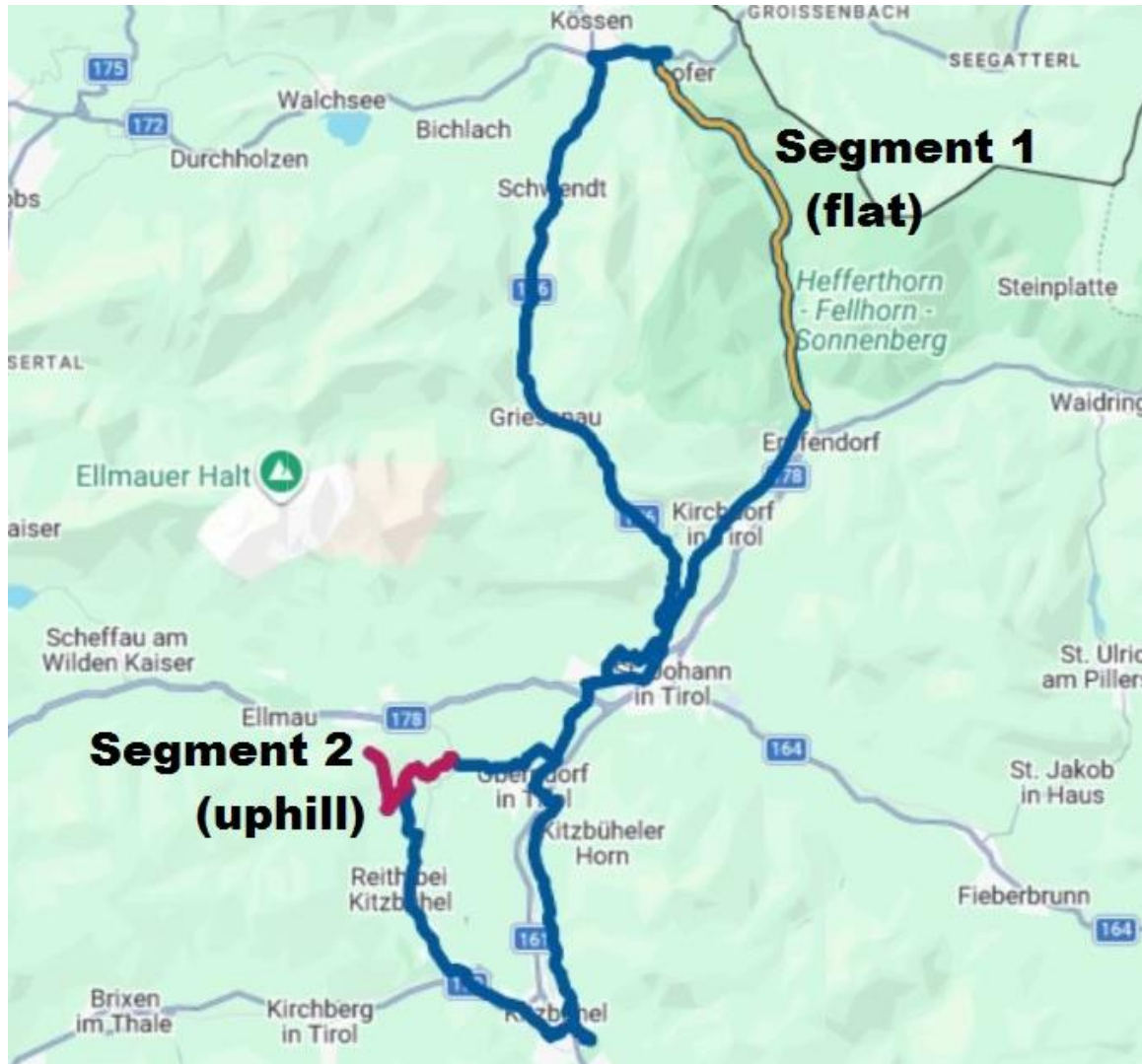


- **Location** **Kitzbühel / Austria**
- **Race day** **Saturday, September 5th, 2026**
- **Race mode** **Segment race**
- We will ride a 72 km circuit (900 m elevation gain) in a no-drop pace in groups of 10 riders
- No road closures necessary
- There will be two competitive segments as individual time trials – they decide the titles
- Classifications: Women, Men, Rotaract, Guest class.
- Age groups as in UCI World Championships

- **Segment 1:**
10 km flat
- **Segment 2:**
4 km uphill

Queen and King of the Mountain

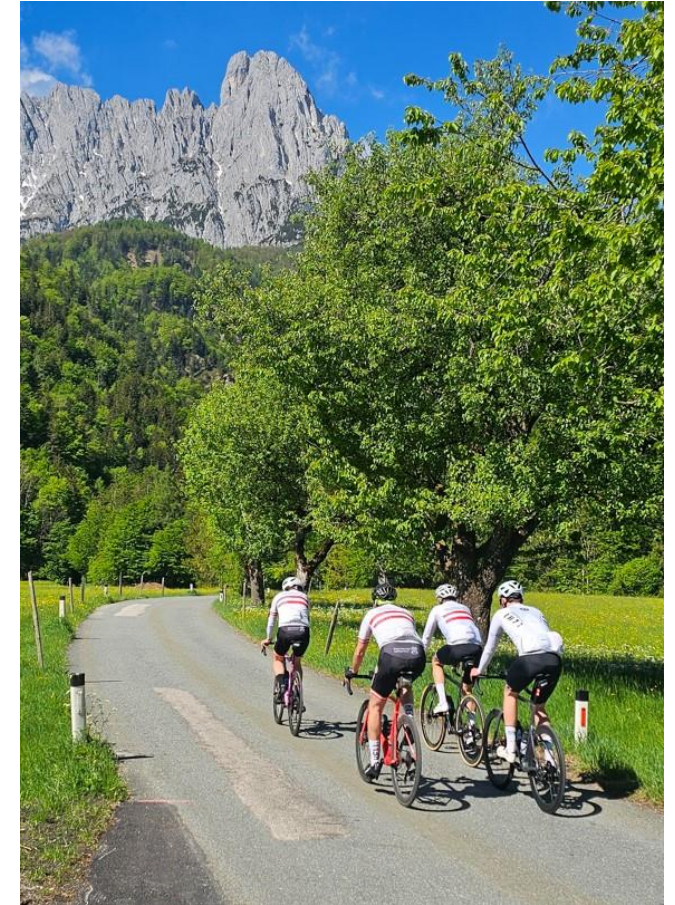
- **Location** **Kitzbüheler Horn**
- **Race day** **Friday, September 4th, 2026**
- **Race mode** **Hill Climb**
 - Group ride to legendary Kitzbüheler Horn in a no drop pace
 - Competitive riders can prove their strength and battle for the *Queen and King of the Mountain* titles.
 - Length of the climb: 7.1 km
 - Elevation gain: 875 m
 - Average incline: 12.5 %
 - Maximum incline: 22.3 %



Kitzbüheler Horn, Austria's steepest mountain road for cycling. One of the toughest hill climbs in Europe.

- **Wednesday, September 2nd**
 - Barbecue evening at the *House of Friendship* (i.e., Schlosshotel Kitzbühel)
- **Thursday, September 3rd**
 - Joint cycling tour with cycling professionals
 - Tour to the start of the world famous Kitzbühel Ski Race (on foot)
 - International Rotary meeting in our *House of Friendship* (Panel discussion: Dr. Kurt Matzler, others to be determined)
- **Friday, September 4th**
 - „Queen & King of the Mountains“: hill climb challenge up to the top of Kitzbüheler Horn, steepest mountain for cycling in Austria: 7,1 km, 875 meters in elevation, 22.3 % incline
 - „Tyrolean Evening“ at Rosi’s Sonnbergstuben

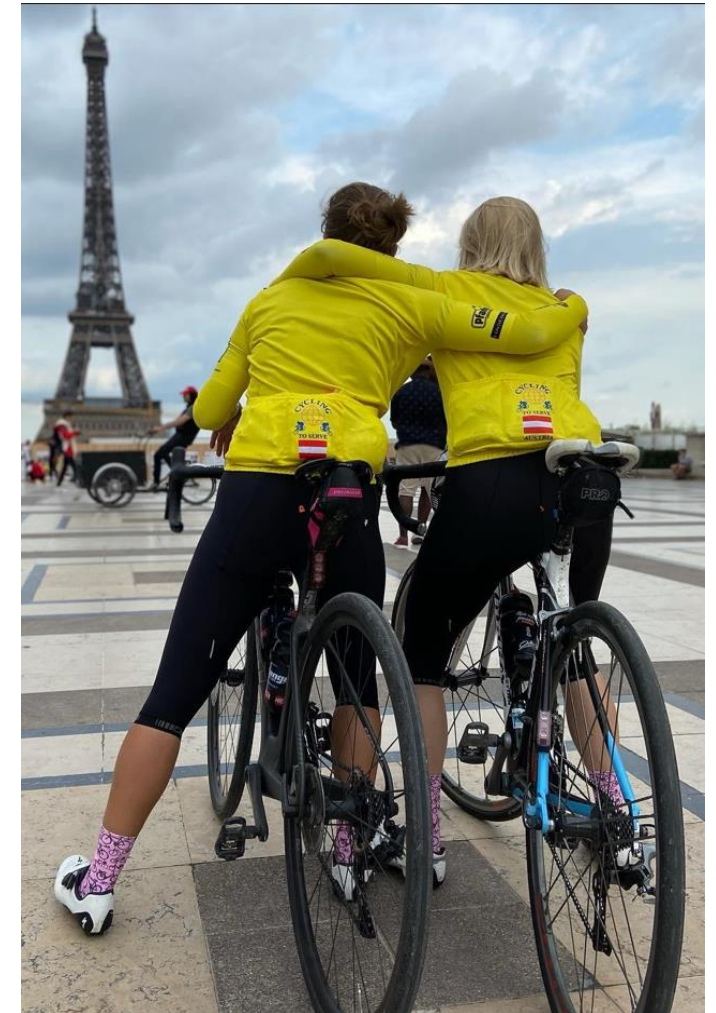
